

Some of Laura's Favorite Evergreen/Semi-Evergreen Plants

Sun- 6 hours or more of sun

Skullcap, evergreen, low and tidy- flowers red, pink and purple Euryops daisy, evergreen, neat and clean-flowers yellow Snow rose, evergreen small shrub 2-3'-flowers white Roses, shrub, Earthkind® and groundcover roses- all colors, Knock Out® roses especially

Rosemary, evergreen, light blue flowers inwinter Mexican Honeysuckle, gray green foliage, semi evergreen flowers orange Hollies, evergreen-red berries in winter Star Jasmine, evergreen vine-flowers white

Part Sun- Morning full sun or 3-6 hours of sun (not hot sun)

Fringe Flower, evergreen shrub, outstanding color-fuchsia flowers Dwarf Ruellia, long bloom season Mexican Honeysuckle, gray green foliage, semi evergreen-flowers orange Japanese Yew, evergreen, interesting shape Sedums, some are semi evergreen, low and neat

Shade or filtered (not to deep) bright to 4 hours "cool sun"

*Variegated Ginger, can die back if cold enough but comes back Camellia, evergreen, winter color-flowers lots of colors (great in containers) Gardenia, evergreen, flowers cream color Heavenly bamboo, evergreen, reddish winter color Holly fem, evergreen

Honorable Mention

Cenizo or Texas Sage

Plumbago Mexican Olive Magnolia, evergreen (especially Teddy Bear) Palms Crepe Myrtles, deciduous but interesting bark and beautiful flowers
