Native Shrub Common Name	Evergreen	Cold Hardiness	Blooms
Agarita	✓	15°F	<b>Early Spring:</b> Yellow flower clusters Summer: Edible red berries
American Beautyberry		10°F	<b>Late Summer-Fall:</b> Clusters of purple berries lined on stems
Apache Plume	semi	-10°F	<b>Early Summer-Fall:</b> Rose-like white blooms that fade to gorgeous pink tassel seedheads
Black Dalea		15°F	<b>Summer-Fall:</b> Purple, pea-like flowers
Blue Shrub Sage ( <i>Salvia ballotiflora</i> )		15°F	<b>Summer:</b> Aromatic shrub with blooms of white, blue or purple.
Button Bush		10°F	<b>Summer:</b> 1" round, pom-pom-like white flowers
Coralberry	semi	-20°F	<b>Fall:</b> Red clusters dense with berries
Creosote Bush	✓	0-10°F	<b>Spring-Winter:</b> Small, butter-yellow flowers
Elderberry		-10°F	<b>Summer:</b> White, flattened clusters of flowers <b>Summer-Fall:</b> Edible, black, berry drupes
Evergreen Sumac	✓	10°F	<b>Late Summer-Fall:</b> Clusters of tiny white flowers followed by red berry drupes, red fall foliage
Fairy Duster	semi	15°F	<b>Spring-Summer:</b> Red-pink, tassel-like flowers
False Indigo		15°F	<b>Early Summer:</b> Yellow-tipped, dk. purple flower spikes
Flame Acanthus (Hummingbird Bush)		10°F	<b>Spring-Late Fall:</b> Orange/red, tube shaped flowers
Fragrant Mimosa		0-10°F	<b>Spring-Summer:</b> Balls of pink puff flowers, fragrant

Fragrant Mistflower		10-20°F	Fall: White flower clusters
Guayacan	✓	10-20°F	Spring-Early Fall: Purple/pink flowers
Holly: Possum Haw Yaupon	✓ (Yaupon only)	-10°F	Fall-Winter: Red, orange, yellow shiny berries
Kidneywood		10-20°F	Spring-Fall: Tiny, white flowers on spikes
Lantana (Texas)		10-20°F	Spring-Winter: Vivid mixed orange hues on flower clusters
Mountain Sage		10-20°F	Spring-Fall: Scarlet red flowers
Roughleaf Dogwood (large shrub/small tree)		10°F	Summer: Flat-topped, white flower clusters
Shrubby Senna		10-20°F	Summer-Fall: Sunshine yellow, pea-like blooms
Silktassle	✓	10-20°F	Fall: Inconspicuous purple flower drupes on female plants
Skeleton-leaf Goldeneye	semi	10°F	Summer-Fall: Bright yellow, daisy-like flowers
Texas Mountain Laurel	✓	10-20°F	Early Spring: Cascades of fragrant, purple flowers
Texas Sage	✓	5°F	All Year Long: Purple, pink or white flowers (dep. on variety), appear especially after a rain.
Wax Myrtle	✓	0-10°F	N/A, fragrant foliage
White Brush (Bee Brush)		10°F	Spring-Fall: White vanilla-scented flower spikes
Woolly Butterflybush	semi	15°F	Spring-Fall: 1/2" round orange flowers
