

reminders for how to water flowers:

- water around the roots of flowers, avoiding overhead watering that can bring on fungal issues
- water flowers deeply and infrequently, rather than shallow and frequent
- flowers in pots tend to dry out faster than flowers planted in the ground
- most flowers need at least an inch of water per week whether by you or by rainfall. periods of dry, hot weather may warrant more watering than usual
- water in the mornings to avoid losing water to evaporation
- rainwater is best, but you can neutralize tap water, if needed to remove chlorine, by letting it sit for a day before using it



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
