TRY SNAPDRAGONS IN YOUR “THRILLER, FILLER, SPILLER” CONTAINERS.



ROCKET, CHANTILLY	LIBERTY, SONNET	SNAPSHOT, MONTEGO, CANDY- TOP
30–36” tall x 16–18” wide.	18–22” tall x 12–14” wide	6–12” tall x 10–12” wide.
<b>Best Landscape Uses</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Back of borders</li><li>● Center of island beds</li><li>● Cut-flower rows</li></ul>	<b>Best Landscape Uses</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Middle of borders</li><li>● Mass plantings</li><li>● Along walkways</li></ul>	<b>Best Landscape Uses</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Front of borders</li><li>● Edging and carpet plantings</li><li>● Small spaces</li></ul>
<b>Container Role</b> <b>Thriller (vertical accent)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Pair with mid-height fillers like Liberty or dianthus</li><li>● Underplant with mounding/edging varieties</li></ul>	<b>Container Role</b> <b>Filler (color body)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Surround a taller Rocket or grass thriller</li><li>● Balance with a low edging plant at the rim</li></ul>	<b>Container Role</b> <b>Spiller (soft, mounded edge)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Let plants billow over the rim slightly</li><li>● Great in bowls, window boxes, and mixed combos</li></ul>
<b>Look:</b> Upright, architectural; long stems packed with florets	<b>Look:</b> Well-branched, dense spikes; classic snapdragon form	<b>Look:</b> Low, mounded habit with tidy, full spikes

Snapdragons (*Antirrhinum majus*) are cool-season annuals that thrive in the fall, winter, and spring across Texas. Their tall, upright flower spikes come in an array of colors—perfect for creating show-stopping beds, borders, or mixed containers.
