



‘POLBIG’ 2026 RODEO TOMATO

CHARACTERISTICS

- Determinate, Hybrid
- F1 Disease Resistant
- Early Bush-Type
- Quick Maturity (56-59 days)
- Resistant to Cracking
- Holds Well on Strong Vines
- Reliable Harvest
- Medium-Sized (7-10 oz.)
- Meaty Texture
- Mild, Sweet Flavor
- Sets Fruit in Warmer Temps (Spring/Summer) and Cooler Temps (Fall)
- Great for In-Ground Gardens, Raised Beds, and Containers

SPRING EARLY TOMATO CARE

- Buy tomatoes early while selection is ample.
- Plant small transplants deeply into 1 gallon containers with a quality potting mix, so they can grow a strong root system while also being protected until soil and air temps have warmed to support plant growth.
- Place some Espoma Bio-Tone in the bottom of the planting hole.
- Offer bright light indoors until the danger of frost has passed, use grow lights if needed.
- Adequately water, but do not over water. Always feel soil before watering.
- Include a diluted liquid fertilizer every other watering.
- In general, tomatoes should get in the garden by March 15th, depending on weather.
- Keep frost protection handy just in case.
